

Wallacespace CSR Policy

Wallacespace believes that a clear conscience means clear thinking. That's why our sustainability practice means a lot to us.

Recycle First Mile are our waste disposal people. They sort our recycling waste by hand, separating out the stuff that can be used again, and correctly disposing of the bits that can't.

We have recycling bins in all our rooms and we recycle food waste in our kitchens.

We choose our soft-drink brands by looking at their eco-credentials, and the packaging for our bottled juices is always recyclable.

Reduce We use energy-efficient light bulbs throughout our spaces. We don't turn our lights on for 'show' when no one is here and all our rooms have their own air con, meaning that we don't need to waste energy heating up or cooling down rooms when they're not in use.

As well as looking at the recycling credentials of our soft drinks, we take into account the food miles created when making their way to our spaces. This helps us to reduce our carbon footprint.

The food we use in our kitchens is always seasonal, plus our meat and vegetables are sourced from fair-trade and organic sources where possible, as reflected in our menus.

Reuse When finding locally produced food is difficult, we use Sainsburys to deliver our groceries. They use electric delivery vans, cutting down on fossil fuel consumption. Our packed lunches are packaged using biodegradable waxed cardboard containers and any disposable cutlery is made from sustainable wood.

In our rooms we use water coolers instead of bottled water, so that the containers can be taken away and refilled instead of using plastic bottles. Our branded pens are made from reused cardboard and (excluding the ink refill) are 100% biodegradable.

Forward thinking

As our spaces and ideas grow, so does our commitment to managing that growth in a considerate way. We are always on the lookout for ways to improve our eco-credentials and best sustainability practice.

We've recently discovered the beauty of bamboo flooring - bamboo is a rapidly growing grass and not a wood. It can be harvested every 3 - 5 years, unlike wood, which makes it an extremely environmentally friendly and sustainable flooring product. We aim to replace our carpets with bamboo flooring wherever practical.

Community

We know that our spaces are part of a wider environment. We try to replicate the attention to detail that we practice inside our venues to the way we act outside them too.

Our St Pancras venue is a member of the Woburn Residents Association, and we are committed to developing our relationship with the businesses and residents around us.
