

Access at wallacespace Covent Garden

Wallacespace Covent Garden is an historic coach works from the 1820s, and has variously been a print works and most recently a creative agency over the years. There are some things we have changed to make it more accessible, but sadly there are also some limitations.

There is no lift to the other floors but on the ground floor there is a accessible loo, 2 meeting rooms and (of course) teas, coffee and lots of snacks.

The caffé is downstairs on the lower ground floor, down a wide set of stairs. If you're unable to visit the caffé, we can arrange to serve breakfast and lunch on the ground floor in your room so do let us know if that would be helpful.

There are no steps into the building entrance but the pavement curb outside on Parker Street is 20cm high.

Please let us know in advance if you'll need a hearing loop.

We aim to make a visit to wallacespace a pleasant and stress free experience for everyone.
