

## **Access at wallacespace Covent Garden**

**Wallacespace Covent Garden** is actually two buildings at **53** and **60 Parker Street**, side by side, just off Kingsway and a stone's throw from Covent Garden and Holborn tubes.

We aim to make a visit to wallacespace a pleasant and stress free experience for everyone. There will always be things we can't change about the structure of our buildings but we are a helpful bunch so if you have any questions at all about accessibility (or anything else), please give us a call and we will do our very best to help. Please let us know in advance if you need a hearing loop and we can arrange this for you.

## **53 Parker Street**

There's a small ramp leading to the entrance of **53 Parker Street.** We're on the 1st and 2nd floors which are accessible by stairs and a lift. The lift is at the far end of the lobby and measures 80 x 90cm.

There are breakout spaces on both floors with a variety of teas, coffee and plenty of snacks. The caffé for breakfast and lunch is on the 1st floor and there are 4 meeting rooms on this floor which you can request if needed. We have gender neutral loos on each floor. Our loos at 53 Parker Street aren't currently wheelchair accessible. We do have other buildings with wheelchair accessible loos so please do speak to one of our team on 020 7395 1265 for advice as to which of our spaces will work for you.

## **60 Parker Street**

There aren't any steps into the building entrance but the pavement curb outside on Parker Street is 20cm high. As is the case with older, characterful buildings, there isn't a lift to each floor but we do have an accessible loo on the ground floor which has two meeting rooms and (of course) teas, coffee and lots of snacks.

The caffé is downstairs on the lower ground floor, down a set of stairs. If you're unable to visit the caffé, we can arrange to serve breakfast and lunch on the ground floor in your room so do let us know if that would be helpful.
