



Access at wallacespace St Pancras

Wallacespace St Pancras is a converted Victorian warehouse. There are some things we have changed to make it more accessible, but sadly there are also some limitations.

There is no lift to the other floors but on the ground floor there is a large accessible loo, 3 meeting rooms and (of course) teas, coffee and lots of snacks.

The cafe is downstairs on the lower ground floor, down a fairly narrow and steep set of stairs. We can arrange to serve breakfast and lunch on the ground floor, either in your room or just outside it so do let us know if that would be helpful.

There are two small steps (the largest is around 12cm) down from street level to the front door. We have a ramp, you can either let us know in advance that you may need it or give us a call when you arrive on **020 7395 1265** (this number serves all of our buildings but whoever you speak to will be able to help).

The front door is 77cm wide, with a side section that can also be opened to allow a maximum width of 113 cm.
