Recycle

All of our bottled drinks are recyclable + our still + sparkling water is served in reusable glass bottles.



First Mile are our waste disposal people and we don't send anything to landfill. We recycle 96% of our waste and anything that can't be recycled is turned into energy.

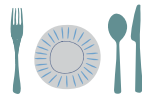


All our tech, including any ink cartridges + screens are recycled by First Mile.



Reduce

We use energy efficient light bulbs throughout our spaces and don't turn lights on just for 'show', switching off anything not in use.



Our ingredients are fresh, seasonal and sourced locally where possible.



Our meat and fish are certified & traceable, meat is Red Tractor assured & fish is MSC certified.



Reuse

When we make packed lunches we use biodegradable cardboard containers + wooden cutlery.



If finding locally produced food is difficult, all of our food delivery people use electric delivery vans to cut down on fossil fuel consumption.



We provide still + sparkling water on tap in our caffes + use glass carafes + glasses with our water coolers rather than plastic cups.



Forward thinking

We provide tasty Belvoir cordials for those who would like something tastier than water but don't want to take a drink in disposable packaging.



We only use eco cleaning products across our buildings.



In 2019 we planted the first of the trees that would become our 'wallywood'. We now have around 2350 trees across the English countryside.
