

## Access at wallacespace Clerkenwell

Wallacespace Clerkenwell Green is our most accessible building.

The front door has a step free entry and is 220cm wide. The door has assisted entry so it only needs a gentle push and from reception we can see anyone coming in so we'll be on hand to help or answer questions.





The caffe is on the ground floor and there are accessible loos on the ground, 2nd and 4th floors, although if you are in Penthouse A you may need to head down two floors in the lift.

The door width for accessing the loos is 67cm at its narrowest point. The doors to our rooms are 79cm wide.

There is a lift to all floors and the floors are fairly easy to navigate as there are no steps. The width of the door to access the lift is 80cm. Once you're in, the lift is 127cm x 132cm.

The maximum weight capacity of the lift is 750kg. It has 1 x handle The buttons light up but it has no audio.

Please let us know in advance if you'll need a hearing loop.
